

Internal Ranking Rounds (IRR) 2022-23 by Moot Court Society

The Moot Court Society of St. Joseph's College of Law, Bangalore, organized Internal Ranking Rounds (IRR) for the students of Law pursuing BA. LL.B., BBA. LL.B., B.Com. LL.B. and LL. B programmes.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Developing skills of written and oral advocacy among students,
2. Striving to give students exposure to courtroom procedure and practice, and
3. To ensure that the best teams represent SJCL at various National Moot Court Competitions for the academic year 2022-2023.

PROPOSITION DETAILS:

The proposition was drafted by Mr. Monosijo Bhattacharjee and all the queries regarding the same were clarified by him. The proposition is based on prohibition of unlawful conversions which is similar to the present "UP Prohibition of Unlawful Conversions Act 2021". The proposition is based around the arrest of Jodha Sharma upon an FIR registered by an advocate. The proposition had five issues which raises the question of:

- A. How the current act accords arbitrary powers to the functionaries;
- B. The contents of the Schedules in Act, if they are violative of Ar.21;
- C. Can the arrests made for contravention of the provisions of the act constitutionally justifiable;
- D. If the onus of proof being shifted on the accused is in the spirit of criminal jurisprudence and
- E. The constitutional validity of the Act in respect to Article 25.

EVENT DETAILS

IRR consisted of 4 Main Events - Researcher's test, Draw of lots, Memorial Evaluation and Oral Rounds. The Researcher's test and draw of lots were conducted on **6th January, 2023**. The oral arguments were conducted on **7th January, 2023**.

➤ Researcher's Test

The Researcher's Test was conducted to test the student's ability to examine their understanding and researching skills based on the moot problem. It was a pen and paper based test with a total of '30 questions'.

➤ Draw of lots

The sides to be argued by the teams were decided by a draw of lots on the 6th of January, prior to the commencement of the oral rounds of competition. The Memorials of the opposite teams were duly exchanged immediately after the draw of lots.

➤ Memorial Evaluation

The participating teams in the IRR had to submit a soft copy and three hard copies of the memorials from both sides of the petition. The same was meticulously evaluated by Mr Moses Raj, Ms Tejaswini, Ms Jyothi, Mr Harish, Ms Shobha and Ms Sangeetha as per the criteria provided to them.

➤ **Oral Rounds**

The oral rounds were conducted on 7th January, 2023 from 9 AM to 4 PM. A total of 38 teams who submitted the memorials reached the oral rounds of the Competition. They were judged by the distinguished members of the Bar. Every team was required to argue both as the Petitioner and the Respondent.

The oral rounds were divided into two rounds. The first Round of the competition was held as Round 1- Part 1 between 9 am to 10 am and Round 1- Part 2 held between 10:15am to 11:15am. The Second Round of the competition was held as Round 2- Part 1 between 11:45am to 12:45pm and Round 2- Part 2 held between 1pm to 4pm.

The oral rounds were followed by the valedictory ceremony. Thanking all the participants and volunteers, the MCS announced the prize categories with its respective winners.

The prizes were distributed by the Director, Principal and Vice Principal.
